The 70th anniversary ceremony, in the home of Count & Countess Arnaud de Pontac, the Chateau de Servigny, was a moment in time that will be remembered forever by all who attended. With a guest list that included a long list of honorable personalities such as France’s Minister of the Interior – Bernard Cazeneuve and the Patron of the event Mme. Pascale Trimbach –Permanent Representative of France for UNESCO. In keeping with the theme, speeches, poems and songs were given about Peace. However, the highlight of the day was the unveiling of the mural “Mosaïque de la Paix”. With over 30,000 glass tiles donated by Bisazza, Italy, the mosaic mural project was directed & coordinated by Stacey Wilson-McMahon. The mural depicts peace symbols created by 101 children from 4 schools in France and children with cancer from the Institut Curie in Paris and the Ronald McDonald House in Villejuif, France. Watching the smiles on the faces of children who participated in the project light up as the mural was unveiled for all to see was a “magical” moment demonstrating that **a patch works** by “changing the lives of children one patch at a time”.
